

Informasjon til selvfinansierte kandidater

Brukes som standard svar ved henvendelse fra aktuelle kandidater.

NB! Sendes kun til kandidater som vurderes av instituttet som reelle, attraktive kandidater. Som hovedregel skal selvfinansierte kandidater ikke tas opp.

In order to apply for the PhD programme you normally have to be appointed for a PhD position. In some cases self-financed candidates may be accepted. You may only apply as a self-financed candidate if you have an agreement with a supervisor at a department at The Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences.

Self-financed candidates may either have private funds, state scholarship or salary from private firms.

If you want to be self-financed you and the supervisor will have to sign a written agreement regarding who is responsible for expenses like:

- Expenses / travel resources for participation at seminars and conferences
- Stays abroad
- Expenses for use of infrastructure, office space etc.
- Costs related to defence, supervision, mid-term evaluation, administration etc.
- Travelling, pc, textbooks, course fees etc.

Be aware that you are not eligible for social benefits, paid parental leave and other welfare schemes when you are in Norway as a self-financed PhD student.
