

- Knowledge of
  - the services offered by the University Library
  - how scholarly information is screened, published, organized and retrieved
  - which information resources (databases) the library offers w/in maths and natural sciences







- Knowledge of how to
  - find useful search terms
  - build efficient and timesaving searches
  - screen search results
- Knowledge of which tools exist to help keep up w/current development
- Knowledge of how to organize and use references (Endnote)





- Knowledge of criteria for
  - ranking publications
  - evaluating individual researchers and institutions (science indicators)




- Knowledge of

  - open acces
